Purpose:

Objectives:

The creation of a synoptic picture regarding the impact of climate change on socioeconomic behaviors and performances at global level, the political and legislative responses to them as well as the study of the latest trends and developments at the level of the European Union and in Romania regarding the energy market. Also, studying the socioeconomic impact of legislative changes in the field of energy.

Design/Methodology/Approach:

Carrying out the comparative study of specialized literature with focus on the parallel between the liberal approach, inspired by market processes, and the canonical statist ones, the cross-sectional analysis of the energy market in the member states of the European Union to identify the response, common actions and differences, as well as the primary data analysis on the energy sector on all of its components.

Results/originality:

Detailed analysis of the energy sector highlights its relationship with CO₂ and CH₄ emissions, emphasizing the potential for sustainable development through investments in green technologies.
