Purpose:

The project assesses Romania's current situation, identifies the main problems and issues, analyzes the economic, social, and political benefits of joining the Schengen Area, as well as the costs and risks associated with joining or not joining. It formulates recommendations and proposals that can underpin strategies and public policies in the field.

The project identifies concrete actions to accelerate the process of Romania's accession to the Schengen Area and to maximize the positive effects resulting from this process.
